

OLYMPIC DREAM

Taking the chance of being reunited for the 32th World Mountain Running Championship here in Sapareva Banya, Bulgaria, as athletes representing the Italian National Mountain Running Team, we would like to share with you some ideas on a topic we believe it is fundamental for the future mountain running: becoming an olympic discipline. We all think this is a primary step to continue the growth of our movement, and a common goal each one of us needs to work on to find shared consent and support.

In a moment of great interest towards the whole off-road running world, still continuing to grow and to attract an increasing number of people, we firmly believe that our discipline has both the numbers and the dignity to become part of the olympic program: high technical level, many countries involved, a good race format and a reasonable duration that make it very spectacular for media and public.

We are fully aware of the fact that the procedure to be recognized as an olympic sport needs to go through the official channels of Federations and National Olympic Committees, and we also are certain that this is an essential step to openly pursue our olympic dream, despite the challenges and difficulties of the process.

This document does not have any critical aim; on the contrary, it has a completely positive and constructive target. Our intention is to start collecting the approval of all athletes and participant Countries to this World Championship to effectively work on this project, drawing the attention of each National Federation on this topic. It is very important to show our interest and work together: if we join our efforts and share our thoughts and dreams, we will be more successful.


We are Athletes: we can run fast and race hard, pursuing our dreams and ambitions. We hope that our Federations and supporters can help us make them true with the same passion and courage.


